
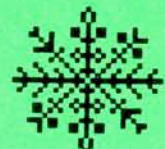




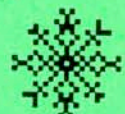
## HOLIDAY GREETINGS FROM OUR TO YOURS





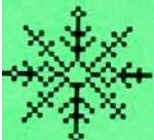
Another year has come and gone. We hope that yours was a healthy and happy one.

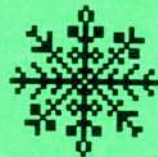
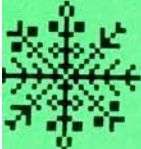
In August, 58 people joined us for our third annual lot party in Barrington Hills (can the  construction be far behind?). 




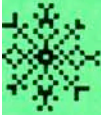
Kelly turned fourteen ( $\times 7 = 98$ ) last March.  has cancer but as usual her only concern is where the next food treat is coming from. 







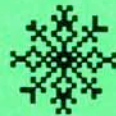
